Supply List:

- Professional Grade tube watercolors, good choices of brands include: Winsor Newton, Holbein, Daniel Smith, Daler Rowney, Schminke, M.Graham.
 - Recommended Colors: Choose one from each line
 - Cobalt Blue
 - Permanent Rose, Alizarin crimson, or Quinacridone Rose
 - Winsor Yellow, Aureolin, or Hansa Yellow
 - Prussian blue, Antwerp blue, or Winsor blue (Phthalo Blue)
 - New Gamboge or Raw Sienna
 - Winsor Red, Pyrrol Red, or Quinacridone Red
 - Payne's gray, Indigo, Sepia (or other neutral black or gray)
 - Other Optional colors:
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Viridian or Phthalo green
 - Cadmium Scarlet, Burnt Sienna, or Transparent Pyrrol Orange
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Cerulean blue
- Brushes
 - ½" Flat brush
 - # 10 or #12 round watercolor brushes
- Paper (9" x 12" or larger works well)
 - 140# cold-press watercolor paper
 - A watercolor block (Arches or Winsor Newton)
- Additional Supplies
 - 2 plastic containers for water
 - Paper towels/ rags
 - Palette (plastic or butcher's tray enamel)
 - Drawing pencil
 - Spray bottle
 - Ruler
 - ¼" or ½" masking or artist's tape
